

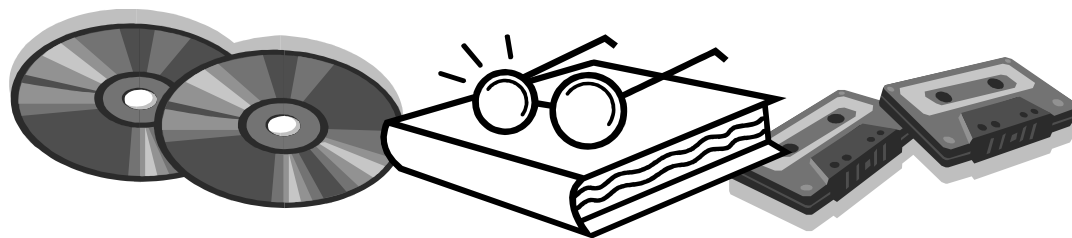

After completing a brief form about your reading preferences, **you will have items delivered to your home through the mail.** Return postage will be provided. You may also make requests for titles or authors that you would like to receive.

All you need is a Moline Library card!

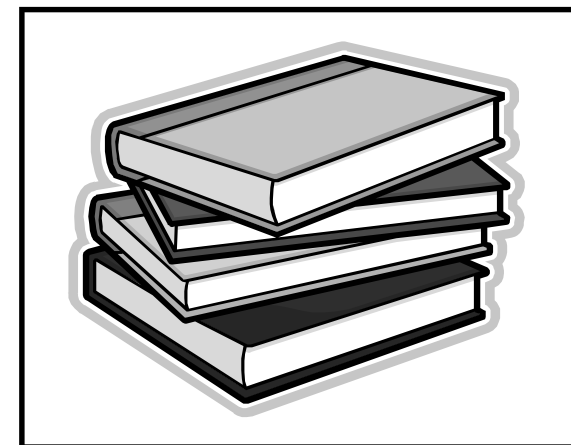

To qualify for the Homebound Program you must meet the following criteria:

1. The user must be a Moline resident.
2. The participant must have or obtain a valid Moline library card.
3. The participant needs to be homebound without mobile relatives or friends living with the patron.
4. Must be willing to accept and abide by the rules governing the delivery and pick-up of library items.
